McLaren Vale Hop on Hop off Tour

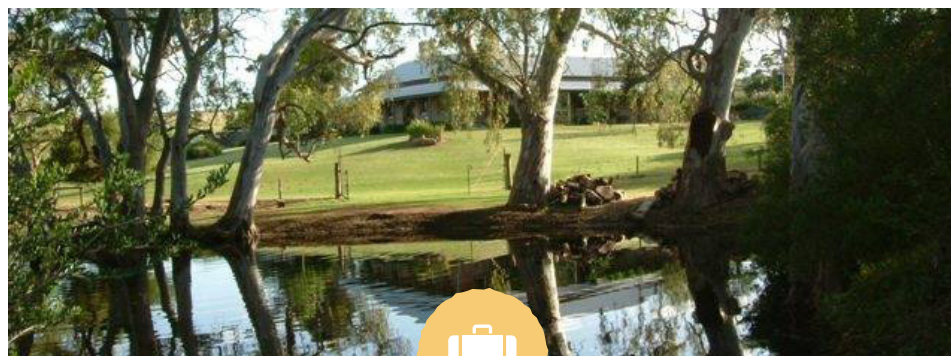
