Deep, dark maroon

Rich and full-bodied, fresh black fruits and great complexity. Layers of flavour and length in the mouth. Beautiful tannins and fresh acidity to finish.

14.5%

25% New American oak and French hogsheads
75% Older French and American oak hogsheads
