WALK OR KAYAK

The Onkaparinga Estuary stretches over 10km from Old Noarlunga to the sea at Port Noarlunga. The estuary and its surrounds provide a diverse landscape including the river, lagoons, floodplains, sand dunes and samphire flats.

The trail offers opportunity for walking, birdwatching and photography. Along the trail are interpretative signs that provide information about the flora and fauna of the area. The wetlands loop is a true surprise and in fine weather is also accessible for strollers, mobility aids and wheelchairs.


