## WINE & VINTAGE

2021 was one of the best vintages we have ever had in McLaren Vale. After two years of very low crops and drought, 2021 was perfect in almost every way (apart from a global pandemic that is!) We snuck a few whole bunches in our Grenache this year, so you may notice a bit more of a floral lift and lovely long tannins to round out the palate. Glory to gorgeous Grenache!

## AROMA

Red berries and forest floor- earth, spice, lifted rosewater and violet aromas. Nettle and ironstone, fresh and bright, jumping out of the glass.

## PALATE

Super crunchy red currant notes, chalky tannins, mouth watering savoury flavour. Cocoa dust, cranberry juice, all the things! So many layers and so much to love.

## THE YEAR THAT.....

2021 was also a great year for mushrooms. We have a forested section on our Taranga vineyard, and it was brimming with field mushrooms. There were many a foraging session, and Don led the charge. Cooked up in butter and enjoyed on toast with poached eggs- delish!
