To Stay **Kingo's Surf School & Camps**



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Kingo's Surf Schools operate all year round in South Australia. Lessons are run at Goolwa Beach. Locals, visitor's, and backpackers in Adelaide can join a surf class or surf camp either at Goolwa or the Eyre Peninsula. Accommodation is available in Goolwa Beach for \$30/night if you want to get in as much practice as possible after your lesson.

With a Physical Education teaching degree and a background in Special Education, along with many years as a swimming and aquatics instructor. Kingo has developed his own unique style of teaching surfing, which makes the sport accessible to anyone. There are no restrictions on who can learn to surf. Anyone can do it.

The surf camps run over 5 days and are a highlight and an opportunity to appreciate the ocean every day.

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The Bikeway is an on-road and shared trail that links the coastal city of Victor Harbor and the river port town of Goolwa, via the coast of Port Elliot and Middleton. The total distance of the bikeway is 30km. However, a range of riding distances make it suitable for all ages and range of fitness.

The Bikeway can be used by cyclists, walkers, skaters, rollerbladers and is wheelchair accessible.

or find a cozy spot next to the wood fire heater to curl up with a book and a tea.

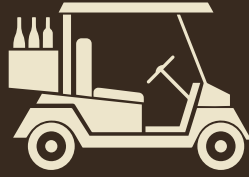
