

Seaside haven Port Elliot, just a bit further down the stunning coastline from McLaren Vale, has plenty to draw you in.



If you're trying to be more responsible with your fashion choices, then head to new fashion boutique <u>*Ciclo*</u> in Strathalbyn.

Meaning 'cycle' in Italian, *Ciclo* want to bridge the gap between new and used apparel - by selling both under one roof.

They are part of the slow fashion movement, which encompasses ethical practices together with eco-friendly fabrics, and long lasting high-quality design with the goal to recirculate pieces for years to come.

To aid in the re-circulation, they offer a buyback system, meaning people can return used *Ciclo* goods for a store credit, and they can be re-sold and loved again.

This year, join the <u>*Winter Whale Fest*</u> festivities from 1-30 June in Victor Harbor, just over half an hour south of McLaren Vale.


Home to the <u>South Australian Whale Centre</u>, Victor Harbor is a great seaside town to explore, with lots to do for the whole family.

The perfect, cosy couple's retreat, the *Coach House* has been immacualtely renovated to create an ideal escape for a winter get away.


