The funky interior, styled by owner of *Boomers Bar*, and artist, Shelley, is all mismatched wallpaper and upcycled furniture


With great snacks, cakes and fresh breakfast staples, this is a great way to enjoy the beach and start the day right. And of course the coffee is delicious!

Beginning on the 28th September, the 2024 South Australian *Nature Festival* offers over 400 events across the state, in order to connect, learn and embrace Nature.


Themed around the central concept of Awe, the 2024 festival wants everyone to feel the awe that nature provides, throughout a huge calendar of events.

## **Vale 194**


How do you fit in everything you want to see in McLaren Vale? Difficult, right?
